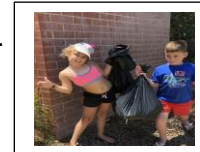

### EAR BUS

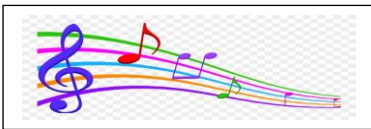
The Ear Bus came yesterday, Wednesday 19th February and will return later in the year to check all Indigenous children.

## Music News



The Music Aptitude Indicator Test is a listening test given to Year 4 students across W.A.

It provides a measure of a student's ability to hear sounds in patterns.

Out of 2,636 students from 75 Metropolitan and Country Primary Schools the average, or mean score for Pitch was 9.47 out of 20, SVPS students averaged 9.61 out of 20.

For Rhythm the state average was 3.95 out of 10. The Swan View average for tune recognition was 4.84 out of 10.

Swan View Primary Schools students scored an average of 5.1 out of 10.

This means that on average our students scored higher than the state average in all areas of listening.
